plains, with mountains rising only in the south-central part

World heritage sites: Ancient cities of Polonnaruwa, Sigiriya and Anuradhapura, Golden Temple of Dambulla, Old town of Galle, Sacred city of Kandy, Sinharaja Forest Reserve, Central Highlands of Sri Lanka

Official languages: Sinhala, Tamil, English

Political system: A republic and unitary state governed by a semi-presidential

system
