Application Form

Please provide **three** copies of each of the following:

- Completed application form;
- A project proposal demonstrating what you would like to do while in Beijing and outlining your specific artistic rationale for wanting to be resident there. Your project should have local relevance to China but not be limited to China;
- Details of the programme of presentations you plan to undertake on your return to New Zealand;
- Your CV, outlining artistic accomplishments, awards, exhibitions, published work etc;
- Three letters of support from industry professionals;
- A list of equipment needs, clearly indicating what you will provide and what you will need to source in Beijing;
- Examples of your most recent work and a link to your website if you have one. (Do not send originals. Examples on CD or DVD will be accepted but please send three copies);
- Copies of recent articles, reviews, and catalogues.

All support materials submitted must be clearly labelled with your name. Do not send any material spiral bound or in clear file or plastic folders.

Applications should reach Asia New Zealand Foundation **BY NO LATER THAN 5pm Friday 25 September**. Late applications will not be considered.
