윷놀이



Yutnori is one of the most popular traditional games in Korea. It is basically a board game with four halved wooden sticks and played like dice which land either face-up or face-down (flat side).

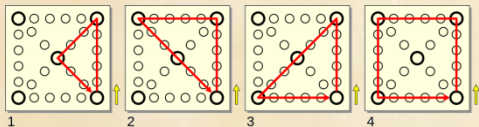
This game was derived from divination rituals.

How to play



1. The players, divided into teams, throw the sticks into the air then move a counter on the Yut board according to the number of sticks which have landed face-up and down (flat side).
2. The team which moves all four markers around the board first wins

Yut Board



1. The four possible courses of the game of Yut. In order to turn at the corners, the counter must be landed on the corner first.
2. If the counters land on the same team, these counters will move together.
3. If the counter catches opponent's counter, the player gets another turn.

1. One facing up stick makes "do" which means to go 1 step forward.
2. If the player gets yut or mo, the player will go 4(yut) or 5(mo) steps forward plus an extra turn.
