1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. **Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of the Terms and Conditions.**
2. The partners of this competition, the Asia New Zealand Foundation and Paralympics New Zealand reserve the right to store electronically any mascot designs sent in by entrants and to use the images free of charge in any of their online and print publications.
3. The competition is open to New Zealand students in Years 7-10. You must have a **New Zealand address** available to you to enter. Employees of the Asia New Zealand Foundation, Paralympics New Zealand and their immediate families are ineligible to enter.
4. To enter the competition, entrants must complete the [Survey Monkey](#) application process and create their mascot design on the template provided.
5. By entering this competition, you give Asia New Zealand Foundation and Paralympics New Zealand all rights to your image or design. The image or design will be used by the Foundation and Paralympics New Zealand and will not be passed onto third parties.
6. This promotion is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter or any other social network. You are providing your information to Asia New Zealand Foundation and not to any other party. The information provided will be used in conjunction with our **Privacy Policy**. 7. The competition opens at 9:00am on 19 July 2021 and will close at 5:00pm 6 August 2021.
8. Mascot designs must be the work of the entrant and photograph of design to be submitted as a high definition **JPEG or PNG** file between **800KB and 5MB in size**. Shortlisted entries will be contacted to provide a **PDF** file of their design.
8. Category winners will be selected by a panel of judges made up of stakeholders from the Asia New Zealand Foundation, and Paralympics New Zealand. The Asia New Zealand Foundation and Paralympics New Zealand's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. The winners, their parents/caregivers and school will be notified by email. Inability to contact the winner will result in the prize being forfeited.
10. The winning mascot designs will be announced via Foundation and Paralympics New Zealand's social media channels. Entrants are to state on competition entry form whether they are happy to be named or wish to remain anonymous in which case only the school will be named and not the student.
11. There are two category prizes to be won; best mascot design for Y7-8 and best mascot design for Y9-10. Each category prize winner receives and a 30-minute class Zoom session with a Para athlete. will also be awarded for mascot designs shared on social media where the Asia New Zealand Foundation has been tagged correctly.
12. The prize is not exchangeable or transferable and cannot be taken for cash. The prizes will be sent to the student's school and the zoom session will be arranged with the student's teacher.
13. Entries must be submitted via the format provided during the mascot competition period (**19 July – 6 August 2021**). The Asia New Zealand Foundation and Paralympics New Zealand are not responsible for entries sent late or misdirected.
